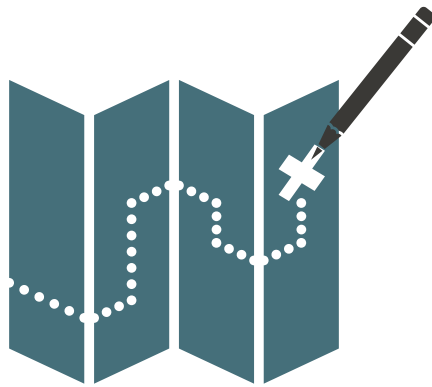


The Roadmap to Revival

Welcome to the Roadmap!

At first glance, planning revival seems to presume on God's grace. How dare we try to figure out what's in God's mind and heart for our generation?

Yet, we might ask ourselves why, if we have the mind of Christ, wouldn't we?

"...even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual... But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ." -1 Cor 2:11-16

Are we not to use this spiritual judgment that comes from the mind of Christ in us? If I had the chance to ask Jesus, face-to-face, the most important question of all time, I would ask him to show me how to operate in revival mode.

I can't bring revival, but I can "compare spiritual things with spiritual." I have online access to volumes of info about what revival mode has looked like through history.

Why wouldn't I want to learn how revival operates? Why would he not tell me?

It's not special revelation- it's more of a matter of common sense. Jesus has common sense too, right? I'm going to give you a rough structure, just to open creative dialogue.

As far as I can tell, the basic framework for an individual (like me) to move from survival mode to revival mode includes **4 phases, detailed for you in the rest of this roadmap:**

1. I make it my main objective to build human relationships with God. (Mt. 22:37)
2. My local church experience is restructured to best nurture these relationships.
3. Regional institutions tailor a self-replicating plan for discipleship to my culture.
4. Missions training communities send groups of missionaries to implement revival.

Phase 1: It's your main objective to build people's relationships with God.

The 3 Steps of Spiritual Fitness Coaching:

Coach unbelievers to be born again by giving people your *testimony* in a brochure with your contact info in it.



Tip: Give out your testimony all the time (step 1), but ask God for **one person at a time** to coach in step 2.

Coach new believers to journal their prayers so that they can pray God's desires as He shows them in his book.

If they would like to receive Jesus as their savior, use *The Worship Course* (or *The Worship Handbook*) to help them hear God's plans and desires for them.



Coach a group of mature Christians as they coach others in personal, spiritual fitness.

Meet with each one regularly, helping them grow in their relationship with Christ using *The Worship Course* and *Strategy Book*. After this, teach the basic spiritual disciplines using *The Worship Notebook*, then use *Prayer Partnerships* to help them find a partner.

A Sample Spiritual Fitness Plan

Phase 1 is all about **getting ourselves healthy before we try to change the culture.**

Becoming spiritually fit takes hard work and dedication. But, we know that seeking first God's kingdom and leading others into right living will pay off like nothing else ever will.

Maybe you've been waiting for someone to describe revival mode to you. If you're longing for a **step-by-step action plan to get in the game**, this is for you.

Here's an example of what Phase 1 might look like in everyday life:

1. Begin regular prayer journaling by taking our free *Worship Course*.
2. Polish your 1-page *testimony* and give a copy to one person whenever you go out.
3. Use *The Worship Strategy Book* whenever you feel negative emotions.
4. Begin using *The Worship Notebook* each morning when you wake up.
5. Create a *Prayer Partnership* to support your prayer routine.
6. Do *The Battle Plan Challenge* with your prayer partner. Get into a weekly routine.
7. Begin *coaching* one person from your sphere of influence in spiritual fitness.
8. Get your family or organization in the game with *ground rules and accountability*.
9. Join *The Sophiculture Society* to get coached in coaching others. Create a profile.
10. Join a weekly warfare coaching group for teamwork and support. Check in daily.
11. Begin *The Heartview* intensive Bible study with your family and/or small group.
12. Help your group members go through the above steps to form their own groups.
13. Coach them as their groups split off from your group, until they're on a roll.
14. Keep up with those you've coached. Make sure they remember that they're always welcome to come back to your group whenever they need a break from coaching.

Phase 2: Church is restructured to nurture our relationships with God.

Online tools help us concentrate our energy on using our unique gifts all week long.

The 5 Functions of the Local Church in the Digital Age (from Ephesians 4:11-13)

1. Wholehearted Teaching

Our regular church assemblies nurture our left-brain through classes and sermons. Our right-brain is nurtured through worship music & the arts.

2. Relevant Evangelism

Leaders equip church members to hand out flyers with their own testimonies, then help people to get born again and plugged into personal discipleship.

3. Pastoral Shepherding

Overseers provide counseling in difficult situations. They help people make community connections for food, clothing, schooling, jobs, and other needs.



4. Prophetic Accountability

Trailblazers facilitate creative networking for writers, artists, songwriters, media producers, etc. in order to ensure the scriptural integrity of their work.



5. Apostolic Networking

Church-builders create a missions base where they can train teams to build a cultural infrastructure of revival, both locally and overseas. (Phase 4)

Phase 3: A self-replicating plan for discipleship is tailored to each culture.

The regional hub is a sociological lab for business, education, media and government. As a team, local churches write the strategy for transforming their sub-culture.

The 5 Branches of Cultural Development



1. **Religion:** God is authoring a historical awakening of every tongue, tribe and nation to wholehearted worship. We partner with him to repair the doctrinal fragmentation of his body with focused, evangelistic teamwork among local churches.



2. **Business:** God's people are the light that shines with integrity in a dark world. Regional teamwork among Christian businesses provides a model of generosity, as well as healthy competition to encourage optimal talent development.



3. **Education:** Bible-centered education opens realms of discovery that our current system has yet to tap into. Redesigning our educational system for the success of the student (rather than the success of the school) means doing targeted character coaching to develop each relationship with God.



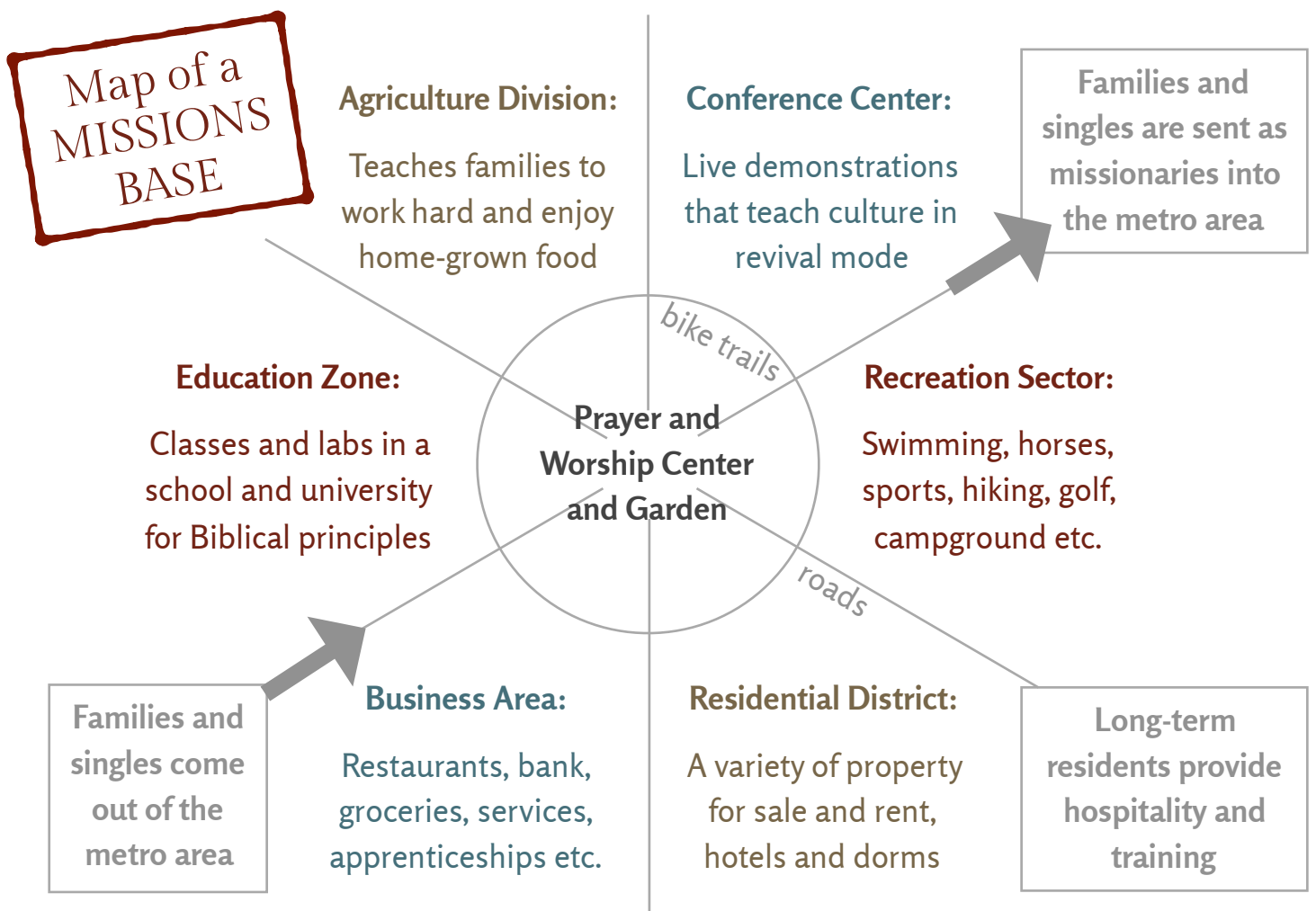
4. **Media:** Arts and communication are venues of truth expression. The entertainment that we provide for the Christian audience is filtered through an organized body of scriptural principles to ensure its purity and accuracy. Film-making and news media are redesigned to worship Christ.



5. **Government:** Solid culture is built on a platform of governmental integrity. Christians show up at the cutting edge of all philosophical deliberation with scripture in hand. Our safety is secure in the hands of our leaders. And, they can rely on us to hold them accountable.

Phase 4: Missions communities send out groups to implement revival.

All of the regional hubs in one metro area work together to build a **missions base** outside of the city where Christians are trained in revival by immersion. The conference center is nestled within a **worship-centered community** to give visitors a glimpse into **scripturally-integrated culture**. Residents have 24/7 access to recreation, business, apprenticeships, agriculture and live worship. Education is structured to develop the family’s calling to missions. It highlights the gifts of each member on the family team. Children grow up in a culture where the principles of the Bible are rigorously tested within their contexts for powerful application to life in their community. Everyone learns the role that God has for them in building a culture of Biblical integrity. Then, the family is sent back with other families to build revival infrastructure in their city.
